



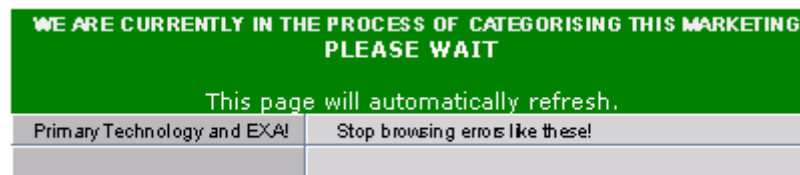

School ADSL Internet Service with Web-Filtering

Primary Technology have partnered with Exa Networks to provide an Unrestricted ADSL Internet Service for Primary Schools. The service is reliable and installation costs are low – Exa make use of Existing BT phone sockets to run the Internet Service.

Initial Setup Costs are £200 for supply and installation of an ADSL router. Annual subscription charges amount to around 60% savings for primary schools currently on the Bradford Learning Network (formerly Bradford Broadband).



What changes?

Switching to Exa involves two changes for primary schools; both can be completed seamlessly without affecting any changes to the network.

- Installation of a new ADSL Router
- Replacement of existing Cache devices

The immediate impact will be to stop browsing errors when trying to view content on websites, the 'we are currently in the process of categorizing...' page.

And with **SurfProtect**, Exa's content-filtering service for education, you can add or remove trusted websites at will. Simply email our Internet Support Team and the website will be added within 24-hours and usually within 2 hours (it takes only 5 seconds to allow a trusted website).

Why Change?

Schools have requested a solution to their Internet problems and we moved some schools to Exa as a test. Twelve months on, the test schools are happy with the service and so are we. Please contact us if you would like a reference from a local school.

How fast will it be?

As fast as you like! Exa Networks offer unrestricted download and upload speeds. We recommend a 2mb minimum for most primary schools.
